Known for its exquisitely curated boutiques at luxury resorts worldwide, California's Maris Collective has partnered with the Faena Group for the **Faena Bazaar**, an exercise in commerce that's best described as experiential shopping. "It's completely unique to Miami and moves beyond traditional retail," says hotelier Alan Faena regarding the concept, which opens its doors this month with a cafe, exhibition and event spaces and two floors dedicated to multibrand boutiques and single-vendor shops for men's and women's fashion, beauty and home goods. OMA partner Shohei Shigematsu, who's been instrumental in much of the Faena District's architecture, designed the venue's interior, which is accented with Studio Job's contemporary versions of Victorian garden chairs as well as hand-painted trunks by Voutsas and jellyfish aquariums by The Darwin Sect (all of which are available for sale). If wildlife isn't on your shopping list, consider exclusives like Juice Beauty's Faena Red lipstick, camouflage-embroidered jackets by C. Bonz and Sotris totes by Ximena Kavalekas. Stand-alone stores include Linda Farrow, Pedro Garcia, Adriana Iglesias and Hartel, which houses a small bodega with curiosities such as lighters wrapped in Goyard canvas and old *Playboy* magazines.
